How do you Apply for a Birth Certificate in New York City?

If you were born in any of the five boroughs, the Department of Health will have a copy of your birth certificate on file.

There are 5 ways you can obtain a copy:

You can obtain an application in person, by telephone, by Internet, mail, or fax and fax the application to (212) 941-2172.

In Person Immediate

(between Centre and Lafayette Streets in Manhattan) Take 4, 5, or 6 trains to Brooklyn Bridge/City Hall, or R train to City Hall or J, M, or Z to Chambers Street.

You may obtain a copy of the birth record in person between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. You will need \$15 for each copy as well as a photo ID.

Telephone 2-3 days to 1 week

There is operator service between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm Monday through Friday, and 24 hours 7 day a week automated service. You will need a valid credit card. The cost will be \$15 plus \$5 for mailing or \$11

extra for priority mailing in 2-3 days.

Mail 2-4 weeks

To apply by mail you must obtain a Birth Certificate Application. You can get one by writing to:

Then send a full copy of the application letter with the following:

- A check or money order payable to the **NYC Dept. of Health**(\$15)
- Stamped, self-addressed envelope
- A copy of a signed, valid photo ID of the person named on the certificate. If the photo ID is unavailable, submit 2 proofs of name and address

Fax 2-3 days to 2 weeks 1(800) 908-9164

To get a copy of your birth record, you will need a valid credit card and a completed application. The cost will be \$15 plus \$5 for mailing or \$11 extra for priority mailing in 2-3 days.

Some Extra Things to Know

If you are a minor (under the age of 18) you will need a signed letter from a parent or guardian giving you permission to get a copy of a birth record. This letter will also need to be notarized (signed by a professional witness; ask anyone upstairs in Legal Services

If you are emancipated from your family, you do not need your parents signature to get a birth certificate.

If you have a Social Security number, it will be listed on your birth certificate.

If you are getting a birth record for someone else, they will need to give you a signed, notarized letter giving you permission to do so. And you must have a copy of their photo ID.
